PERMISSION TO PUBLISH IMAGES

The Author must bear in mind that photos, illustrations or artworks may be subject to copyright and it may be necessary to obtain permission from the holder of the rights to reproduce the image (usually by the artist, photographer, editor or the Museum which holds the work).
